## Earthquake Kit and First Aid Supply List

Should an emergency or disaster situation ever arise in our area while school is in session; we want you to be aware that Maria Regina School will be prepared. In a <u>one-gallon</u> zip lock bag label your child's first name, last name, grade and teacher's name. Following is the list of items your child is required to bring to class by <u>on the first day of school</u>.

- First Aid Kit
- Emergency food (snack) dried fruit, beef jerky, granola bars, cheese/peanut butter crackers, etc.). Place these snacks in smaller baggies. **NO** loose snacks that could attract ants.
- Water (1 plastic bottle/16 Oz.)
- Emergency survival Blanket
- Essential medication and medical supplies (if applicable)
- Flash light & batteries
- Small packets or travel pack of hand-wipes

\*Note\*: All supplies should be sufficient for at least a minimum of one week and label **ALL** items. Also, feel free to write a love note and include a picture.
